Glynnis Dunfee of the Delaware County Health Department reported they mailed 3400 mailings for the 2026 Health Assessment Report. They are hosting a free crib program. They are also supplying free guns safes. There will be a CPR class on July 13-17 for \$100. There is a Clinic on the Health Department bus. There are Free Tire Drop off stations on July 18 and October 3.

Tim Wasson sated he was glad that Sunbury put the moratorium on the Data Center proposed for Sunbury. Almendinger reported that most Data Centers have their own fire suppression and that it seems like everything that Sunbury does is under Emergency. Chad Neeper said that the moratorium isn't really a big deal because it will take 5 years for AEP to run the lines.

Doug Reidel asked Trustees to approve a REA for Murphy Road paving work. Motion by Almendinger to proceed with the REA for Murphy Road:

Doug Reidel reported that the Pelotonia will be crossing Boston, Ross, Green Cook and Trenton on August 2.

**TRASH DAYS:** Almendinger reported that he received 40 ton approved at \$37.50 from Health Department and confirmed with Rumpke. Fisher reported that Liberty Tires is \$515 drop and pick up for 40 yard at \$350 ton and Simms is still \$367.29/trip with rebate from steel.

**BSTG FIRE DEPARTMENT:** Fisher reported that in April there were 160 runs with 25 being in Trenton. The new station 352 should be open for occupancy in two weeks. The ladder had water seal problems and will be repairing damage and all repairs and then it will be on duty.

The Trenton Township Trustees will accept sealed bids for resurfacing (Item 422MS – without polymer binder and use #9 aggregate limestone 22# per square yard minimum Single Seal RS-2 – 0.35 gal/SY) and (SS1H asphalt liquid cut with water @ 1:1 ratio applied @ 0.08 – 0.10 gal/SY) for up to 5 miles of various Trenton Township roads of 18' width on a per mile unit basis. Also said bids will be received on or before June 3, 2026, at 7:15 p.m. at the Regular Meeting of the Trenton Township Trustees.

Bids will be accepted on a unit price bid for Ohio Department of Transportation specifications.

All items are to be furnished and applied by the successful bidder in accordance with the Ohio Department of Transportation specifications and at the direction of the Trenton Township Trustees.

A bid bond, cashier's check, certified check or letter of credit equal to 10 percent (10%) of the unit price bid multiplied by the Engineer's estimated quantities shall be required.

A performance bond in the full amount of the bid shall be required from the successful bidder. Said bond shall be in the name of the Trenton Township Trustees within ten (10) days from the date of award.

The successful bidder shall comply with Sections 4115.03 to 4115.16 Ohio Revised Code, Prevailing Wages for Public Improvement.

The Trenton Township Trustees reserve the right to reject any and/or all bids.
