MANAGEMENT REPORT: Trustees signed Management Report dated June 4, 2025

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: Jessica of 3060 CR 605 reported that the house at 2756 CR 605 had gun fire and loud music. She reported that their dogs and kids were in her field. They burn trash/garbage in their back yard, have a party trailer with lights. Almendinger said he will call the sheriff and all the neighbors need to call. Justice said we all need to get more attention to be paid to this property.

ROAD BID: Only one bid was received for the Trenton Township road work for 2025 and it was Mid-Ohio Paving for \$28,772/mile for up to 10 miles of 18' width with fog seal. Motion to award Mid-Ohio Paving the road work for up to 10 miles of Trenton Township roads to chip and seal and fog seal of \$28,772/mile: Justice
