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HELD AT:	Trenton Township Maintenance and Office Building, 15495 Hartford Road, Sunbury, OH 43074
ROLL CALL:	Chairman Justice called meeting to order. Roll call: Richard Fisher – here, Kevin Justice – here, and Mark Almendinger - absent
MINUTES:	Fiscal Officer read minutes of November 3, 2025, meeting. Motion to approve: Fisher Second: Justice Vote: all -yes, motion carried.
BILLS:	Motion to pay bills: Justice Second: Fisher Vote: all - yes, motion carried.
MANAGEMENT REPORT:	Trustees sign Management Report dated December 3, 2025
PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:	Candi Smith reported that she has not seen black dog around house at C.R. 605 Chris Fitch (township building neighbor) is removing the dying maple and elm in the rear of his property to help with the construction of the fence the township is installing. Ellis Lane asked about the stop sign at Creek and Centerburg and speed limit sign. Justice will call County about installing the sign. He also asked why we don't have yellow lines on Perfect. Fisher answer that chip and seal roads are hard to stripe. Asphalt is good and is only on Trenton and Creek because of OPWC money used. We have installed speed limit signs; however, they were stolen. Lane said the County has little monitors on their signs that they can trace if stolen. Trustees agreed that they did not think so but would check with the County.
BSTG FIRE DEPARTMENT:	Fisher reported that there was a total of 135 runs in October with 23 being in Trenton. They had two resignations from firefighters. The Chief will be working with ISO in July to lower insurance rate for residents. The end of May-April the new station will be open. The prevention vehicle was broadsided causing \$2400 in damage. Firefighter week reported 875 Students were taught. The Christmas party is Dec 6 from 5-8 at the station.
ZONING INSPECTOR REPORT:	Dattilo reported issuing 2 Zoning Certificates. The 4-wheeler company at Condit and Meredith State Road has applied for a new building showroom. They are located in a Limited Industrial District. There are 5 lots of five acres each on west side of Longshore that have been divided. DRPC will inspect their CAD. Motion to receive Zoning Inspector Report: Fisher Second: Justice Vote: all - yes, motion carried.
CEMETERY:	Any equipment Issues? No Barney reported two burials: Elizabeth Dove and Roberta Jasnoch. Barney received two mower estimates for a Lazer Z S-Series, 25.5 HP Kaw, 52" Series 4 Deck, Mulch 526 kit, Sun Shade kit and trade-in: Buckeye Valley Equipment \$9178. Voss Bros \$7878. Justice motioned to purchase Lazer Z S-Series, 25.5 HP Kaw, 52" Series 4 Deck, Mulch 526 kit, Sun Shade kit and trade-in from Voss Bros \$7878. Second: Fisher Vote: all – yes, motion carried.
ROADS:	Any equipment Issues? Yes Barney replaced the cutting edge on snowplow and replaced screw on plow shoe that raises and lowers shoe.

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RECYCLING: Barney reported that the recycling was on schedule sometimes.
