## REGULATIONS ON CULVERTS IN TRENTON TOWNSHIP

- 1. Where a property owner places a culvert into an existing ditch to permit the construction of an approach, it is the duty of the property owner to pay for the culvert, stone, and to maintain the culvert.
- 2. Where a ditch is dug or relocated by the Township along a *TOWNSHIP ROAD* destroying existing approaches the Township will pay to recover all culverts and aggregate.
- 3. If the old culvert is defective and must be replaced, the property owner shall pay for the replacement culvert and aggregate.
- 4. The minimum culvert size allowed along Township roads will be 30 (thirty) feet long by 12 (twelve) inches in diameter. As the size culvert required will vary according to the situation, the proper culvert size over the minimum must be determined in consultation with a Township Trustee or the Township Road Supervisor.
- 5. All culvert installations must be approved by a Township Trustee or the Township Road Supervisor.
- 6. If a property owner wishes to tile a ditch, it is to be done at property owner's expense, be the minimum required for driveway culverts and must be approved by a Township Trustee or Township Road Supervisor.
